

KCCT Results Are Released And Reiley is Celebrating

Campbell County Highlights of the 2008-2009 KCCT test results:

- Campbell County School District ranks 14th among all county school districts, with the 6th highest transition index of the 120 county districts in the state!
- Campbell County School District is now ranked 30th in the state of 175 districts.

Reiley Elementary Highlights of the 2008-2009 KCCT test results:

- Reiley is ranked 132nd out of 743 elementary schools, placing us in the top 17% of elementary schools across the state.
- The percentage of Reiley students that scored Proficient and Distinguished increased in every subject area, except Social Studies(down 1.44%) and Math(down 0.83%).
- Our area of biggest improvement was Science with an 11.04% increase in proficient and distinguished.
- In Reading we increased our proficient and distinguished by 6%.
- Transition Index for Reading 104.43, Math 105.8, Science 114.09, Social Studies 92.27, Writing 90.5

Reiley's overall transition index is 103.

Our goal was to reach 100 this year and I am thrilled we surpassed our goal. We are going to celebrate as we set our new goal and determine the ways in which we will surpass our goal for the 2009-2010 school year. I am very proud of the students, staff and families who made our 2008-2009 school year a success. It takes high expectations and all of us working together to move Reiley from great to greatness.
