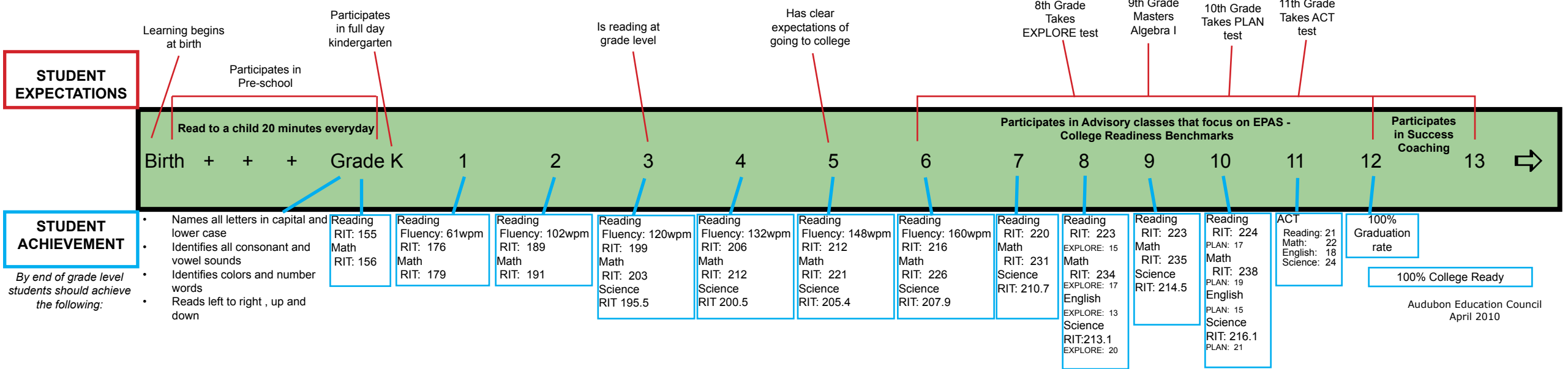




Academic Success Timeline



MAP

MAP is a computer based adaptive test given three (3) times a year. All K-10 students take reading and math each testing season and on occasion also take language usage and science. Students' scores are reported as a RIT. The Academic Success Timeline notes the expected RIT scores for each grade level.

EXPLORE/PLAN/ACT

EXPLORE is the first test in a series of national tests that include the PLAN and the ACT. 8th graders take this each September and are tested in English, math, reading, and science. The score your child receives is a benchmark for college readiness. Scoring for the EXPLORE ranges from 1 to 25.

PLAN is the second test in a series of national tests that include EXPLORE and the ACT. Sophomores take this test in September and are also tested in English, math, reading, and science. The score your child receives is also a benchmark for college readiness. Scoring for the PLAN ranges from 1 to 32.

ACT is the college entrance exam Kentucky juniors take each May. It assesses students' general educational development and their ability to complete college level work. This test is also administered on six (6) national test dates. The College Readiness Benchmarks are the minimum test scores required for students to have a high probability of success in credit bearing college courses.
