Dear Parents:

Our thoughts and prayers go out to the Sandy Hook Elementary School community that was devastated by the loss of their children and educators last Friday. I want to assure you that Campbell County Schools take seriously the responsibility of not only providing a quality education but also ensuring that our students are safe. District Office officials, parents, community members, and Campbell County school administrators and teachers collaborate with local law enforcement officials, first responders, and the Kentucky Center for School Safety to develop policies and procedures to address school emergencies.

As a result of this collaboration, all Campbell County Schools have numerous emergency plans in place (fire, tornado, earthquake, intruder, weapons, etc.) and have been practicing for these school emergencies. They will continue to do so throughout the school year. All of these drills and training sessions enable our students and teachers to have the opportunity to implement best safety practices that not only enhance their skills but provide an avenue for the district to gather valuable feedback used to improve our emergency plans. Afterwards, school officials meet to discuss, review, and update their school emergency plans. During this time, all ideas are considered.

Other safety measures implemented by Campbell County Schools include:

- Stationing a School Resource Officer full time in the Middle School
- Stationing a School Resource Officer full time in the High School
- Sharing a School Resource Officer in the Elementary
- Installing an anonymous call line so students and others can report concerns
- Offering crisis and tragedy counseling by school counselors to students

All of our safety procedures and measures are the result of many individuals and groups offering ideas and feedback while collaborating together. We thank everyone for their input and support. Together, we will continue to offer a quality education in a safe and secure environment.
