Filing Workshop

- ◆ Student's tax information (if applicable)
- ◆ FSA ID # (apply for @ fsaid.ed.gov prior to attending this workshop)
Please note that each student and one parent will need to have a fsa id # in order to complete the FAFSA
- ◆ Student and Parents' Social Security #s
- ◆ Parents' most recent federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- ◆ Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- ◆ Records of untaxed income (if applicable)

APPLY YOURSELF: College Application Completion Assistance

- ◆ Websites for all colleges you are considering
- ◆ Any essay, list of extracurricular activities, or other information your college of choice may be requiring
- ◆ Social Security # (asked for on many college applications)

ESSAYS MADE EASY: College Essay Assistance

- ◆ Any rough draft of an essay you would like to be reviewed
- ◆ Any essay topic you would like to discuss

RECOMMENDATION STATION

- ◆ Resume or list of extracurricular activities and/or accomplishments
