

## **Campbell Ridge Student Quarantine Work Plan**

All assignments should be turned in on the first day your child returns to school. Teachers will be available for questions via email and Class Dojo messaging.

### **Kindergarten**

Students should expect worksheets from the content areas, ex: Letters/letter sounds, math concepts, high frequency words, science/social studies, etc. These are the same worksheets that are being completed in the classroom while the student is quarantined. Directions on how to complete the work will be communicated to parents.

### **Grade 1 (Della Bella and Klus)**

- Students will receive a packet of the work that will be missed during quarantine. Please coordinate with the teacher when you can pick these up.
  - If the student is actually sick, not quarantining due to exposure, the student can receive their absent work when they return to school.
- Assignments can be returned with the student in their folder when they return to school.
- Students with an IEP will be contacted by their child's special education teacher for more information about their work.

### **Grade 1 (Helton/Berglin)**

Within 24 hours of notifying the teacher, parents should expect to be able to pick up student work in the office.

- Students will receive a packet of the work they will be missing due to quarantining. Students will be expected to complete reading, phonics, writing, and math assignments.
- Student Chromebooks will be sent home for the students to work in IXL and to read on EPIC!.
- Students with an IEP will be contacted by their child's special education teacher for more information about their work.
- Students who are too sick to complete their work, can pick up their work when they return to school.

### **Grade 2**

Teachers will have work available within 1-2 days after being notified a student is in quarantine. Parents should expect to be able to pick up student work in the office. Assignments will include:

- Chromebook with charger for AR, IXL & other technology programs used in class.
- Reading Log--student needs to read 15 minutes each day. They can log on to their EPIC account during school hours to access books. We encourage students to take AR tests after reading their book 2-3 times to work towards their Trimester AR goal.
- Math Journal/packet--student must complete daily assignments to the best of their ability
- Reading Workbook--students must complete daily assignments to the best of their ability.
- IXL--30 minutes daily to include updating Diagnostic and working on recommendations.

### **Grade 3**

For math, students will be assigned math journal pages, home links and IXL lessons based on the daily math lessons. Videos of the math lessons will be posted in the homeroom google classroom under the classwork tab. Parents can communicate with the math teachers through Dojo. Assignments should be returned to the math teacher at the end of quarantine unless other arrangements have been made.

For Reading, students will be assigned assignments including Reading workbook pages and IXL activities that align with the lessons being taught in the classroom. Parents can communicate with the Reading teachers through Dojo. Assignments should be returned to the Reading teacher at the end of quarantine unless other arrangements have been made.

### **Grade 4**

Within 24 hours of notifying the teacher, parents should expect to be able to pick up student work in the office. Assignments will include:

- Chromebook with charger for AR, IXL & Google Classroom access.
- AR books--student must be reading for a minimum of 20 minutes daily and taking AR tests over completed books.
- Math Journal/packet--student must complete daily assignments to the best of their ability, reaching out to the teacher through email to have questions answered.
- Reading Workbook--students must complete daily assignments to the best of their ability.
- IXL--30 minutes daily to include updating Diagnostic and working on recommendations.
- Science/Social Studies--papers will be sent home, video links will be posted on Google Classroom.

### **Grade 5**

Within 24 hours of notifying the teacher, parents should expect to be able to pick up student work in the office. Assignments will include:

- Chromebook with charger for AR and IXL lessons. IXL lessons are specified within the hardcopy students will receive and will be communicated through Google Classroom as needed.
- AR books--student must be reading for a minimum of 20 minutes daily and taking AR tests over completed books.
- Math and Reading Hardcopy packet- The front office has a box of hardcopy packets for students to complete while they are out. This content is tied to the same standard of instruction that students in class are receiving.
- Social Studies- assignments will be communicated through Google Classroom with the specific student. Work for this subject will be turned in through Google Classroom as well.
