At our regular SBDM meeting on July 22nd, our committee agreed to send a request to the Campbell County Board of Education to adopt a 10-point grading scale for the entire Campbell County School District. By adopting this scale, our students will be able to compete with students around the state of Kentucky, in a more equitable manner, for scholarship dollars and for the accumulation of KEES monies. If adopted by the Campbell County School board, our new grading scale would be the following:

A+:	100-97	C:	76-73
A:	96-93	C-:	72-70
A-:	92-90	D+:	69-67
B+:	89-87	D:	66-63

B-:	82-80	F:	59 and Below
