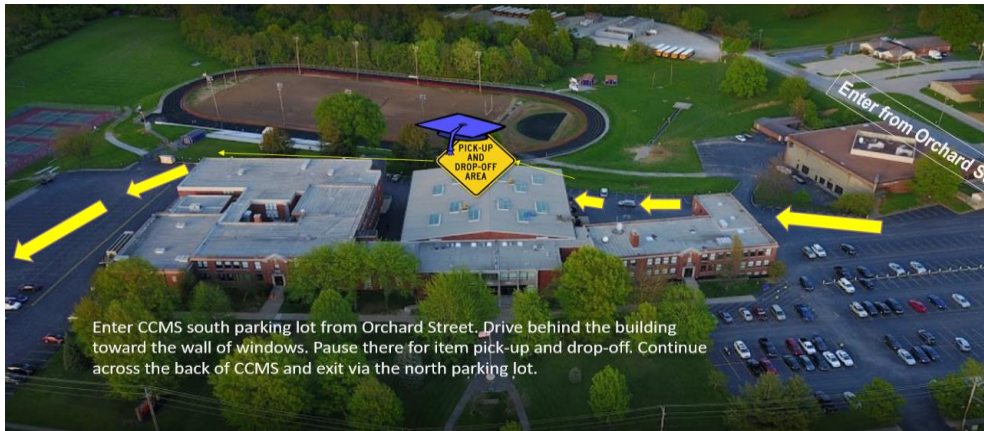


CCMS Update

Dear Parent/Guardian:

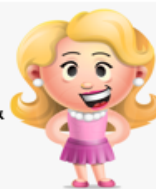
