Dear Campbell County Families and Staff Members,

Campbell County Schools has been administering the Test to Stay Program for two full weeks now with outstanding success, keeping both staff and students in school. To date Ethos has administered 109 tests with only one being positive, resulting in the need for an individual to isolate.

Based on the authority provided via Senate Bill 1 and recent correspondence from the Northern Kentucky Health Department to one of our neighboring school districts, schools have the latitude and responsibility to make data-driven, local decisions regarding the Test to Stay administration. I am, therefore, going to expand the Test to Stay program to permit students and staff greater access to after-school programming.

Once we return from Fall break, and effective beginning on Monday, October 18th, students and staff receiving a negative test in the Test to Stay program may participate in that day's after-school programs in which students remain masked while participating. This may include, but is not limited to, 21st Century programming, extra school services (ESS), tutoring, co-curricular activities and clubs. This exception does not extend to athletes, or band and chorus members, as those students do not typically don masks throughout the entirety of their activity.
