**ALL CAMPBELL COUNTY SCHOOLS WILL BE
HANDING OUT MEALS ON THESE DATES.**

Campbell County Schools is currently offering free meals to all children 18 and under through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA's) Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). These meals can be picked up at any Campbell County School! *USDA has allowed flexibility for this program to continue until the first day of school, which is currently 9/14/2020.* Upon reopening schools whether virtual or in person, USDA is requiring school districts to return to the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). This means that meals can only be served to students who are enrolled in schools in Campbell County and that each student will be served meals at a determined Free, Reduced, or Paid status based on a submitted Household Application for Free or Reduced lunch. These schools include Grant's Lick Elementary School, John W Reiley Elementary School, and Campbell County High School.

If your student attends a school that qualifies for the Community Eligibility Program (CEP), enrolled students will be offered meals at no charge. These schools include Campbell Ridge Elementary, Donald E Cline Elementary School, Crossroads Elementary School, Campbell County Middle School, and Campbell County Day Treatment Center. **More information on how to receive meals through NSLP, during virtual and in person learning, will be coming soon!**
