

As we begin a new week of NTI please review what is expected of your child. Please note that packet work NEEDS to be returned back to school to account for your child's attendance.

During our NTI days this is what we will be asking your child to do:

Each week you will complete your typical homework packets. Included in this is a reading log (10 minutes) and ½ sheet of work per day (10 minutes) as well as Lightning Words (1 minute). Standards for each activity are included on the page.

We will be checking your child's FFW and Edgenuity log ins and progress remotely. Please complete the packets each week and return upon our arrival back to school. Log-ins and packet completions will count for their attendance at school.

- **Log in to Clever:** This is what the students use to login into our learning programs. To access this, go to the Reiley webpage <https://www.campbell.k12.ky.us/8/Home>. Click on Clever or go to www.clever.com. Search for John W Reiley. The first time you log into this you will need to log in your child using their school email address. This is firstname.lastname@stu.campbell.kyschools.us
(ex. jane.smith@stu.campbell.kyschools.us)
Password is: lunchnumberccs (ex. 1234ccs)
- **FastForWord:** Please log into this 3 times a week. To access this, go in through Clever. Student's username for Fast Forward is firstnamelunchnumber (ex. Jane1234) password is clunchnumber (ex c1234)
- **Edgenuity:** Please log into this 2 days a week. To access this, log into Clever and complete at least 2 activities (or the equivalent of 30 minutes). The first time you log into this you will need to log in your child using their school email address. This is firstname.lastname@stu.campbell.kyschools.us

If you are unable to access Compass or FFW from home, or just would like some additional activities with your child, we have attached extra reading and math worksheets. These are labeled as EXTRA work; this is not mandatory for the NTI days unless you do not use technology. Students may also complete worksheets from the Scott Foresman Reader Writer Notebook, these were sent home on Friday. The title of the stories that the worksheets correspond with are labeled at the top of each page. You can search Youtube so that students can listen to the story.
