Opportunity

The Kentucky Commissioner Of Education is seeking applicants to be considered for appointment to the Campbell County Board of Education. You are invited to nominate yourself or someone you know who is qualified to serve on the Campbell County Board of Education representing Educational Division # 3. This vacancy was created by the resignation of Mr. Gary Combs.

Under the provisions of KRS 160.190 (2), this appointment is effective until

- The end of the elected term

This is a public service position and the person appointed will not be employed by the Campbell County Public Schools.

Requirements

Board members must be:

- At least 24 years of age;
- A Kentucky citizen for the last three years'
- A registered voter in the district and voter precinct(s) of the vacancy Campbell County School District Educational Division # 3.
- Have a high school diploma or a GED certificate;
- Must be in compliance with anti-nepotism state laws;
- Cannot provide contract services for the school district.

Responsibilities

School board members are involved primarily in the following areas:

- Developing policy that governs the operation of schools;
- Providing visionary leadership that establishes long-range plans and programs for the district;
- Hiring the district superintendent and issuing annual evaluation reports;
- Setting local tax rates and practicing vigorous stewardship to ensure that all school district funds are spent wisely.
